On the fixed date representative of M/s. Multiline Enterprises were appeared before the Committee and explained their grievances as under:-

"we have certain reservations with regards to Technical Evaluation Criteria of the bidding document which we have conveyed to procuring agency and SPPRA"

The Complaint Redressal Committee (CRC) of grievances & settlement of disputes was constituted vide Notification No. LG/DG/M&E/AD-II/327(1-Sindh)/2017/692, Dated 20.03.2020, issued by Assistant Director-II (PM&EC), Local Government Department, GOS Karachi. in accordance with Rule-31 of Sindh Public Procurement Rules-2010 (amended 2013). COMPLAINT PROCEEDINGS:

- 1. The Chairman CR Committee first asked the delegation of Multiline Enterprise to present its position and details regarding the grievances. The head of the M/s Multiline Enterprise delegation then expressed his concerns in detail and presented his point of view, while the Procurement Committee gave a detailed explanation on each point
- 2. The Procurement Committee also informed the CR committee that some errors have already been rectified and a pre-bid document has been issued, in this regard.
- 3. It may be pertinent to mentioned here that the notification regarding the composition of the CR Committee was issued dated 20.03.2020, but the Chairman CR Committee was kept unaware of this notification.
- 4. It is also noteworthy that uptill now, the Procurement Committee was responding to all the complaints of the bidders on its own. In this regard, no any complaint has been sent to the Chairman CR Committee.
- 5. During the proceedings, the CR Committee came to know that this tender has been postponed five times since 2009.
- 6. As this complaint relates to purely "Technical Evaluation Criteria", the Committee decides that M/S NESPAK, who is also a member of this Procurement Committee as an observer, submit its complete experts opinion and recommendations to the Committee till the next meeting.

7. This Committee further directs the Procurement Committee to submit all the documents related to this tender before this Committee at its next meeting.

CONCLUSION:





Response from Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS

Reservation regarding Clause 17, PART-A, Bidder Eligibility Criteria which states:

"Similar Quoted Fire Tenders and Major Components i.e. Chassis, Fire Pump, Fire Monitor and Water Monitor, must already have been sold and operational in Pakistan."

Please also note the above conditions are in contradiction to each other and it dilutes competition between quality suppliers and manufacturer and hence creates ambiguity for the participation in the bid. Therefore, to ensure maximum participation and to invite international investment, technology and quality equipment in Pakistan, you are requested to allow international references of developed countries also along with Pakistan and South Asian countries references.

It is important to clarify that Selection Criteria given in the Bidding documents is for assessment of the Worth of the firm who is supplying goods or services. For that it is important that the firm who will act as the front face for the procuring agency has enough technical / financial expertise to not only perform the task but subsequently provide O&M services for at least three years beyond delivery date. Any firm or JV interested in the bidding process must be locally registered and comply with the basic required placed. This is good for all the interested parties who can come up with any international product which can comply with already specified specifications in bidding documents.

The purpose of this Clause is to safeguard that technical expertise which exists in local market and also open up avenues for transfer of technology in the subsequent years with proper O&M mechanism. Further, the tender also contains recognized international standards for proposed Chassis and also stipulates origin of Fire Pump, Water Monitor, Foam Mixer, Fire Hose Reel to be EU/USA/Japan. This is to ensure world class performance and quality.

Reservation regarding Note I, PART-B, Technical Evaluation Criteria which states:

"Bidders are required to provide NTN Certificate, Sales Tax, Income Tax Returns and Manufacturer Accreditation including ISO 9001:2015 or ISO 14001 and EN 1028-1 & EN-1028-2 compliance (Fire Pump) Water Monitor must be verifiable to EU / USA, Japanese Origin, Material of Boom Ladder and Turntable should be EU / American / Japan Origin, PTO should owned and certified by Chassis manufacturer, Chassis' Can must be by ECE standard certified and manufacturer audited balance sheet as This clause does NOT suggest that the manufacturer's equipment such as chassis must be certified using manufacturer audited balance sheet. The clause should be read as stipulating three (03) separate conditions as follows:

- PTO should owned and certified by Chassis manufacturer keeping in view international standards and specifications properly maintained.
- (ii) Chassis must be having minimum 220 to 250 HP Water cooled, torque and Traction may vary subject to Engine and gear Design, 4x2 Truck Chassis having Minimum 18 Tons GVW matching



mandatory requirement. If desired certificates and accreditation is not available with the technical bid, will lead to dis-qualification."

No standardized procedure and practice is available to certify manufacturer's equipment from assessment of balance sheet as required by procuring agency. It is also relevant to note that balance sheets, income statements, cash flow statements and statement of equity is used to analyze financial performance of the company and not the manufacturing ability to ensure its company's capability.

requirement of axle weight mentioned in NFPA 1901 (2016) Standard Clause No. 12.1 (Combined weight of all components mention in this clause should not exceed chassis GVW) having compliance with ECE-R14, ECE-R17 & ECE-R29, latest braking system as per International Standard ECE-R13 & NFPA 1901 (2016) Clause No. 12.3.1.1, Factory Built Driver's Cabin having Seating capacity Driver -2 (i.e. total 3 Person) with Standard complete Accessories/Tool Kit.certified by ECE standard.

(iii) Manufacturer must provide audited balance sheet as a mandatory requirement as part of checking financial strength of the bidder and the manufacturer only.

Reservation regarding Part – B, 1 A, Technical Evaluation Criteria which states:

FOR LOCAL MANUFACTURER

Turn Over of Local Manufacturer's Net Sale / Supply of Similar Nature (Disaster Management Vehicles & Equipment for last 05 years) Audited documents from a recognized audit firm shall be submitted.

(i) Upto Rs. 500 Million 05

(ii) From Rs. 500.0 million to 1 Billion 10 (iii) From Rs. 1 Billion to Rs. 2 Billion First of all allocation and division of marks against sales / revenue requirement is unrational and allocated without understanding proper dynamics of industry and budget assigned (PKRs 1.4850 Billion) for the procurement of the equipment. Please note the requirement set for local manufacturer to attain maximum marks Rs 1 -2 Billion that is practical, as discussed Furthermore if we critically analyzed aspects, these clauses can be used to eliminate the firm / equipment by evaluator, which is totally against the fair competition.

The Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS is entitled to gauge the financial strength of the bidders / manufacturers to ensure the tenders can be successfully completed in accordance with specifications. In line with the size of the subject tenders, the Procurement Committee has set financial criteria which are commensurate with the substantial size of the project. However, participation by joint ventures and consortium are also permitted with every partner having proportionate financial and technical strength in case single bidder is unable to meet the set requirements.

D. Reservation regarding Part – B, 2 A, Technical Evaluation Criteria which states:
 FOR FOREIGN MANUFACTURER

The Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS is entitled to gauge the financial strength of the bidders / manufacturers to ensure the

Please note that firefighting and allied products manufacturing industry doesn't has strong financial position globally in terms of revenue and growth. It's a non-realistic figure for any international manufacturer.

tenders can be successfully completed in accordance with specifications. It is NOT acknowledged that the financial criteria mentioned are "non-realistic". In line with the size of the subject tenders, the Procurement Committee has set financial criteria which are commensurate with the substantial size of the project. However, participation by joint ventures and consortium are also permitted with every partner having proportionate financial and technical strength in case single bidder is unable to meet the set requirements.

E. Reservation regarding Part - B, 5 C, Technical Evaluation Criteria which states:

Foam Mixer:

a) Manual "round the pump" foam mixer and fire pump are the same brand

There are certain benefits of manufacturing major component by similar manufacturer but these benefits are not limited only to the companies having tendency to produce equipment and major components under one roof. It is also global practice that most of the sophisticated and advanced technological products e.g. an aircraft uses turbo fans or turbines from best available sources other than their own brands. The paramount example of arranging best component other than original manufacturer is Rolls Royce.


There are numerous manufacturers across the globe that are manufacturing fire pumps and foam mixers to the standard required in the subject tender. However, this is not a mandatory requirement which will render the bidder disqualified if this requirement is not met. It is only a stated preference of the Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS. As such, bidders are open to offer their technical bids accordingly.

However the allied components / parts used in any product must be owned and certified and must comply the international standards specifications the particular manufacturer as mentioned in bidding document.

F. Reservation regarding Note II of Technical **Evaluation Criteria which states:**

> Minimum Qualifying Marks is 80 out of 100 of technical evaluation to declare Substantial Responsive and eligible for Financial Bid Evaluation. Otherwise, their bid will be rejected and their sealed Financial Offer will be returned unopened within 10 working days after acceptance of award of supply.

The requirement of 80% is stringent enough and allocated / designed to facilitate limited companies. The split and marks distribution to achieve this number is not evenly designed and showing imbalance in favor of certain manufacturers and empirically not possible The Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS has set this minimum standard of 80 marks out of 100 of technical evaluation in order to ensure that citizens of Sindh receive the very best quality equipment in relation to lifesaving, firefighting and disaster management. This is only possible from high quality manufacturer. It is envisaged that any top quality manufacturing company will be easily able to meet this requirement. After all, 80% is only a basic pass mark. Further, the subject tenders have the status of International Tenders as per SPPRA Rules, 2010 which stipulate that any tenders of this size for specialist equipment/vehicles



Reservation regarding Clause q (sub clause b),
Part-A Eligibility Criteria which states:

Main components of Fire Tender Units including Fire Pump, Water Monitor, Foam Mixer, Fire Hose Reel should be of EU/USA/Japanese Origin Only. PTO should owned and certified from Chassis manufacturer.

The condition to arrange PTO from chassis manufacturer is not standard market practice and most of the truck assemblers or manufacturer used to arrange PTO from different vendors.

categorised as International Tenders as permissible by SPPRA.

The subject tenders include the highest standards of quality for all major components of the Units (i.e. Fire Pump, Water Monitor, Foam Mixer, Fire Hose Reel), which is understood that EU, USA and Japan origin provide the best quality assurance. These requirements apply to all bidders to maintain the quality standards required. Regarding PTO certification by chassis manufacturer this should NOT be misunderstood that chassis and PTO must be from same manufacturer it is preferred choice of the the procuring agency. The chassis manufacturer only required to endorse / certify the PTO to ensure there are no compatibility issues between PTO and chassis going forward in case of warranty claims in the future. One manufacturer must certify that each and every part/component of the product is as per the required specifications internationally acceptable standards.

H. Reservation regarding the Clause in Bidder Eligibility Criteria which states:

> A declaration on Rs. 5000/- Stamp Paper duly signed and stamped attesting that bidder / JV partner / consortium member / superstructure fabricator / body maker is not blacklisted / in litigation / corrupt / fraudulent procurement practices with any Government, Semi Government or any public sector autonomous bodies or been held responsible for injury due to manufacturing / material defect on any project. tender However, notification / order / circular etc, in this regard, issued by department transparency monitoring agencies issued at any time prior to award of this work shall be complied with.

That the above referred clause 12 of Eligibility Criteria is malafidely designed to technically knock out any person or company for the nefarious designs to award the subject tender to some blue eyed company and/or person.

The said clause is a sincere effort on the part of Procurement Committee, LGDP, GOS to prevent ONLY those companies from competing which are guilty of the specific offences listed in the clause. It is hoped that all bidders would wholeheartedly agree that any firm that is guilty of these specific offences should be prevented from competing on government tenders in order to safeguard the precious public monies. Nonetheless, it is obvious from the clause highlighted that no specific company is being prohibited from competing in the said tender, and as importantly, no company or person is being preferred. Indeed, any bidder is most welcome to participate. As such, any assertions declaring that any bidder's rights are being deprived does not stand up to scrutiny.

It is hoped that the maximum number of bidders / manufacturers will compete in the subject will be in order to engender intense competition which is hoped will get maximum value for the public purse for the citizens of Sindh.
