- 2/. Besides, DIGP Headquarters, Sindh (the then acting DIGP T&T / Chairman procurement committee) and AIGP M.T Sindh, also attended the meeting.
- Mr. Muhammad Atif Majeed, Country Head M/s Falcon-i (complainant) was heard in detail and ample opportunity was provided to the complainant as well as the chairman procurement committee for counter arguments over the contents of the complaint. It is evident that the complainant could not substantiate his complaint. Besides, M/s Falcon-i complained that they were denied the right of participation in bidding process by the DIGP H.Qtrs (the then acting DIGP T&T, Chairman Procurement Committee) and AIGP M.T, Sindh. However, they failed to present any documentary / plausible evidence before the committee to support their claim. They themselves decided not to participate in bidding process on the basis of their own assumptions. Hence their arguments have no valid / justified grounds.

- 4/- It is also pertinent to mention that Falcon-I entered into joint venture with Pakistan Mobile Communication Limited (PMCL) which shows that they were participating in the bidding process, indirectly. The question arises that why they did so when they had any grievances against the tender / bidding process.
 - 5/- The committee also perused / reviewed relevant record of procurement process which was found right / accurate as per SPPRA Rules.

6/- In view of above facts, Redressal committee has concluded that the complaint is invalid and procurement process be proceeded in accordance with SPPRA rules in terms of para-5, above.
