
Background : -

1. The Chief Engineer, Irrigation Kotri Barrage Hyderabad Constituted Complaint Redressal Committee vide his office Notification No. S-151/W-4/CRC/BC/Sakro/2021-22, dated 28.06.2021.
2. The Complaint Redressal Committee meeting was convened for hearing of grievances / complaints of above cited / mentioned bidder / complainant in connection with the NIT invited by Executive Engineer, Sakro Division, Mirpursakro vide No. TC/G-55/955, dated 23-06-2021.
3. All above complainants appeared in the above said meeting (Attendance sheet attached).



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4. That the Complainants namely **M/S S & Sons and M/S GMS Builders & Developers** Government Contractor, informed the Chairman Complaint Redressal Committee, (i) the Procurement Committee was not present on the date of opening Bid (ii) The Bid documents not entertained in the BER of Sakro Division, Mirpursakro.
- The Executive Engineer, Sakro Division, Mirpursakro / Chairman of Procurement Committees, briefed that the both above complainants submit their documents through TCS and contractors / representatives present at the time of Bid opening, all the Procurement members were present at the time of Bid opening and signed attendance sheets (Copy attached), **M/S GMS Builders & Developers** Government Contractor, Documents received at the time of at 3.10 p.m. for evidence receiving of TCS receipt shown before Contractor & Chairman CRC. **M/S S & Sons, M/S GMS Builders & Developers** Government Contractors, Bidding documents were incomplete therefore, they were disqualified as shown in the Bidders Eligibility Criteria.
- ✓ M/S Ghulam Murtuza Enterprises, Government Contractor, submit his documents through TCS and representative was not present on the date of opening Bid and Bill of Quantities of the Contractor only signed on the 1st page and nor on the others pages of the Bidding documents.
- The Executive Engineer, Sakro Division, Mirpursakro / Chairman of Procurement Committees, briefed that the complainant namely M/S Ghulam Murtuza Enterprises bid price / rate entertained and included in the Bid Evaluation report, whereas he did not sign with stamp full on the Bidding documents and BOQs.




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
Proceeding / Decision :-

The Chairman Complaint Redressal Committee (CRC) and Members decided that the complaint should be **disposed off the following points**

- ❖ The complainant submit their documents through TCS and no proof produce that their representative or himself present on the date of opening, hence the complaint that the committee were not with full quorum hence, the complaint is baseless.
- ❖ **M/S S & Sons, and M/S GMS Builders & Developers** Government Contractors, admitted before the Chairman of Complaint Redressal Committee that they could not fill BOQs, full components, hence the pilly disqualification by the Executive Engineer / Chairman Procurement Committee, "that incomplete BOQs / Bidding documents is proved, therefore, complainant's complaint was set-aside".
- ❖ The Chairman has opinion that if Bidder did not sign with his stamp on the all papers of Bidding documents as well as BOQs thus he supposed to be disqualified. Furthermore Executive Engineer, Sakro Division, Mirpursakro / procuring agency will decide the status of Contractor namely M/S Ghulam Murtuza enterprises, whose rates entertained in the BER.
