
**Minutes of the meeting of Complaint Redressal Committee (CRC) for
Tender No. 02 (Large Volume Parenteral held on: 28.10.2021**

A meeting of Complaint Redressal Committee was held on: 28.10.2021 under the Chairmanship of Secretary Health, Govt. of Sindh, in view of Complaint received from aggrieved bidder against technical / financial evaluation finalized by the Central Procurement Committee (CPC) invited by Health Department under Centralized Rate contract system for the year 2021-22. 
Representative of the Complainant attended the meeting and explained their complaint / grievances in details before the committee while the member of experts committee of CPC for evaluation produced relevant record for verification. The committee examined and discussed the complaint thoroughly and after verification of BER and discussion, deliberation on each point of complaint, unanimously decided as under:

1.	<p><u>M/S. OTSUKA PAKISTAN LTD.</u> MIV – 0001, 0012, 0013, 0014, 0016, 0017, 0018, 0019, 0032 & 0033 M/s. Otsuka Pakistan has submitted their grievances on BER of Tender No. 02 (Large Volume Parenteral) as they were declared technically non-responsive in mandatory criteria. They stated that they have quoted only those products which are Thermo sensitive and availed the provision of the clause of the tender terms. They have requested for consideration as responsive. They have more concern on technical evaluation of M/s. Otsuka products and requested for the consideration of following points:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Item No. MIV 0025 Inj. Dextrose 25% Ampoules and they quoted the product which do not comes under the terminal sterilization 121 degree centigrade criteria. In evaluation of point "Report of Drug Testing Laboratory (DTL) / Central Drug Laboratory (CDL)" they have not been awarded any marks whereas they submitted undertaking and should be considered in 	<p>The CRC examined the evaluation/BER and observed that the bid of M/s. Otsuka Pakistan was considered for item No. MIV0004, MIV0007 and MIV0024 as the products were not bottled in polypropylene container. Hence, fulfilling the criteria. However, item No. MIV – 0001, 0012, 0013, 0014, 0016, 0017, 0018, 0019, 0032 & 0033 were declared non-responsive due to not fulfilling mandatory requirement i.e. "Affidavit on stamp paper Rs.100/- and batch manufacturing record of the quoted product for the year 2021 to confirm terminal sterilization at 121 degree centigrade except thermo sensitive molecule". In view of the above CRC rejected the complaint and decided to uphold the decision of CPC.</p>

	<p>“a)If sample of quoted drug declare sub-standard by any DTL/CDL/NIH established under drug Act 1976 are less than 1% since January 2020 to August 31, 2021, 10 Marks” so they requested to please review and may be considered for award of 10 marks.</p> <p>3. In evaluation point “Pharmaceutical equivalence for Large Volume Parenteral” they have submitted the letter for Pharmaceutical equivalence for Large Volume Parenteral but no mark was awarded, so review and may be awarded 04 marks.</p> <p>4. In this point of 5 marks there are two criteria “IV fluid in polypropylene container / bottles with Euro Head caps” they have quoted the products with Euro Head caps so please review and consider for award of 2.5 marks.</p> <p>5. They have submitted all documents required for the tender participation the matter of DIL was also taken up during the technical evaluation that without the manufacturing license they cannot import any raw material and for this purpose they have due approval of the DRAP so may please be considered.</p>
