

MINUTES OF MEETING - GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

Date: August 28, 2023  
Time: 11:30 AM  
Venue: Office of the Registrar, LUMHS, Jamshoro

The meeting commenced with the recitation of the Holy Quran followed by a warm welcome note by the Convener, Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC).

2. The committee convened to address the concerns and grievances raised in connection with the procurement process for the "Construction of Institute of Pharmacy at LUMHS Jamshoro" and evaluate the fairness and transparency of the said process.

3. The committee engaged in a comprehensive discussion, meticulously examining each concern and grievance raised by the complainant. The procurement process was rigorously reviewed to ascertain its adherence to established standards of fairness and transparency. After a thorough analysis, the committee arrived at a unanimous consensus, endorsing that the procurement process had been conducted in a manner that was fair, transparent, and in accordance with the prescribed guidelines.

4. The committee extended an opportunity to the aggrieved party to present their concerns and grievances. Each concern was attentively listened by the committee members.

5. Upon evaluating the complaint and the entire procurement process, the committee formulated the following recommendations:

I. The committee acknowledged that the proposed rates submitted by all the participating bidders were below the engineering estimates. Notably, the bid proposed by the 1st lowest bidder, namely M/S ICE Pakistan, was also below the engineering estimates i.e. 21%. This situation, coupled with the prevailing economic conditions, could potentially impede the progress of the project and pose a risk to its successful completion.

II. During the meticulous scrutiny of the financial bids, the committee detected arithmetic errors. This discovery raised concerns about the accuracy and reliability of the bids submitted.

In light of these observations and concerns, the committee <sup>members (2)</sup> unanimously recommended the cancellation of the current tender process for the "Construction of Institute of Pharmacy at LUMHS Jamshoro". The committee advised that a re-tender may be initiated, with a comprehensive review of the bidding document to preempt any potential future grievances.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks from the Convener expressing gratitude to all committee members for their valuable contributions to the deliberations.
