Overview

The Government of Sindh has recently released the latest amendments to the Sindh Procurement Rules 2009. Equipped with the new, modern and business-friendly rules, it provides an excellent framework for the procurement officers in public and private sector organizations.

The rules focus on fairness, transparency and most importantly 'value for money'. They provide opportunities for procurement improvements through best practices, and ultimately 'Procurement Leadership'. This workshop further fulfills the mandatory eligibility requirement of SPPRA regarding carrying out procurements and allied functions.

The Center for Executive Education (CEE) at the Institute of Business Administration (IBA) Karachi, is organizing five days' workshop on understanding generally "Procurement Management" and specifically "Public Procurement Framework and Regulations in Sindh". 
