SUBJECT: COMPLIANCE OF SINDH PUBLIC PROCURMENT RULES 2010.

It has been observed that most of the procuring agencies are still not using the notified Standard Bidding Documents for Procurement of Works (Small, Medium and Large). Rule-21(3) of Sindh Public Procurement (SPP) Rules, 2010 is quite explicit in this regard. The same is reproduced below:

“Procuring agencies shall use standard bidding documents as and when notified by the Authority”

2. It has also been observed that procuring agencies are not hoisting their Annual Procurement Plans on their respective websites as well as on the website of the Authority. Rule-12(2) of SPP Rules, 2010 stipulates as under:

“The annual or longer rolling plan, as the case may be, thus prepared, will be posted in advance on the Authority's website as well as on website of the procuring agency, in case the procuring agency has its own website.”

3. It is, therefore, requested that procuring agencies under your administrative control may please be directed to ensure use of the notified Standard Bidding Documents and also update their respective websites on priority basis.

SUBJECT: COMPLIANCE OF SINDH PUBLIC PROCURMENT RULES 2010.

Sindh Public Procurement (SPP) Rules, 2010 envisages a comprehensive complaint redressal mechanism; Rule 31 of SPP Rules, 2010 provides mechanism for redressal of grievances. Hence, every Administrative department, Autonomous/ Semi-autonomous organizations and District Government is mandated to constitute a Complaint Redressal Committee (CRC) for redressing grievances of aggrieved bidders.

2. It has been observed with concern that most of the procuring agencies have not yet notified CRCs, which is a mandatory requirement as per above quoted Rule.

3. It is, therefore, requested that procuring agencies under your administrative control may please be directed to ensure constitution of CRC under Rule-31 and furnish copy of the same to this Authority for record.
