Reason for delay	Due to completion of tenure of two Private Members from SPPRA Board the Review Committee was incomplete, hence meetings were not conveyed. Now the Board has

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nominated Members for RC under Rule-32(3) of the SPP Rules, 2010 and accordingly the meeting of the Committee was conveyed to dispose of the Review Appeal.

#### Proceedings of the Review Committee:-

- i. The Review Committee was informed that the appellants were called for the maintainability of their appeals. The committee was informed that they served with notices and letter were also were sent to them on whats-app numbers. They received the letters but did not appear before the Review Committee for the hearing of their appeals.
- ii. The Review Committee decided to consider the appeals Ex-parte.
- iii. The Committee was informed that these appeals had been listed for maintainability in terms of Rule 31(5) as the appellants approached to the Review Committee after 25 days instead of 10 days.
- iv. The Committee was informed that the Appellant filed the complaints on 09.02.2023 as CRC failed to decide within 7 days and appeals transferred to the Review Committee on 16.2.2023. The appellants was required to approach the Review Committee till 26.2.2023. The Appeal period expired on 26.2.2023. The Appeal period expired on 26.2.2023. The Appellants approached to the Review Committee on 13.3.2023 after the lapse of 25 of the transfer of the complaint.

#### Observation of the Review Committee:-

i. The Review Committee observed that the SPP Rules have described time limits for complaint redressal mechanism. In case of transfer of appeal due to failure of CRC to decide the matter within 7 days, the complainants are required to approach to the Review Committee within 10 days of transfer. The rule 31(5) is reproduced as under:

#### Rule 31 (5) of the SPP Rules

- ii. (5) The complaint redressal committee shall announce its decision within seven days and intimate the same to the bidder and the Authority within three working days. If the committee fails to arrive at the decision within seven days, the complaint shall stand transferred to the Review Committee which shall dispose of the complaint in accordance with the procedure laid down in rule 32.]
- i. In the instant matter the appellants could not approach to the Review Committee within ten days of transfer instead approached after 25 days of transfer of complaint. The matter is summarized as below:-

ii. Keeping in view of the above, the committee observed that the appeal was barred under the SPP Rule 31(5) hence could not entertained.

### Decision of the Review Committee:-

 Given proceeding, findings, observations and due deliberations, the Review Committee decided to reject the appeal, for the reasons recoded supra in the observations of the Review Committee. The Procuring Agency is allowed to proceed as per the SPP Rules.
