"At least two works of similar in nature with equivalent or more cost under taken in last three years along with Completion Certificate of Respective Department showing total cost of work along-with colored photographs (At least 4 Photo-graphs)"

The procuring agency also submitted that the procuring agency formulate an appropriate evaluation criterion, listing all the relevant information against which a bid was to be evaluated and criteria of such evaluation was formed an integral part of the bidding documents. It was argued that past experience was required as condition in the bidding documents to choose eligible and qualified contractors who could perform the contracts.

The Appellant complained that the works were of simple and routine in nature but the PA inserted difficult condition to knock out many bidders.

The procuring agency submitted that the works were to be executed for the Repair and Maintenance of Religious worship place. These works required utmost care and experience. Therefore, condition of experience was required to choose eligible contractors.

The appellant submitted that he had applied for two works Sr. No 10 and 52 but the Procuring Agency had shown him in BER of work NO 10 but his bid had not been shown in work 52.


The procuring agency submitted that the appellant was required to submit the bids in separate envelopes but he submitted his bids only in one envelope. Therefore, only his single bid was mentioned in BER.


The appellant also submitted that the CRC failed to decide the matter within 7 days.

The procuring agency submitted that meeting had been called but one of the members could not attend the meeting therefore matter could not be resolved by CRC within 7 days.

Observations of the Review Committee:-

- The Review Committee observed that the appellant was rightly disqualified as he could not fulfill mandatory condition No i mentioned in NIT.
- The Review Committee also observed that the appellant could not prove that the condition NO 1 was difficult and discriminatory.
- iii. The Review Committee also observed that right and proper time for contending the difficult conditions was after the publication of NIT. The appellant could request the procuring agency for clarification of contents of the bidding document in writing in terms of Rule 23, if any condition was considered by the appellant as difficult or discriminatory.





- However, the appellant could not present any document that proves that the appellant did so.
- The Review Committee also observed that the appellant had accepted the terms and iv. conditions of NIT and bidding documents at the time of submission of bids, therefore appellant cannot contend the terms and conditions after disqualification.
- However, procuring agency failed to hold the CRC meeting in time, neither sort out the issue nor responded to the observation made by SPPRA.

Decision of the Review Committee:

Given the proceedings, findings, observations and after due deliberation, in exercise of power conferred by the Rule 32(a) of SPP Rules the Review Committee rejects the Appeal of the appellant as the appellant could not prove violation of SPP Rules during the procurement process.
