1. General conditions & Instructions:

- 1.1 The bidder shall furnish valid whole sale drug license / valid income tax certificate / valid general sale tax (GST) registration certificate and authorization letter of the manufacturing firm to quote the rates.
- 1.2 The tenderers shall quote their rates inclusive of all the liable taxes to federal / provincial and district government and ensure free delivery to the consignee's and ensure replacement of the breakage.
- 1.3 The tenders shall be submitted in two separate envelopes one for technical bid and other for financial bid titled accordingly. The technical bid shall contain all the required documents as given under qualification criteria.
- 1.4 Tenders must be filled in with blue or black ink in the columns provided in the tender from or on separate letterhead duly signed & stamped.
- 1.5 All the entries into the tender must be free from erasing cutting and over writing. In case of erasing, cutting and over writing. Authorized person should initial it.
- 1.6 The rates of each item should be written in figures as well as in words. Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the basis; if there is discrepancy between the unit price and the total price shall be corrected. In case of any discrepancy the price in words will be taken as authenticate and final.
- 1.7 Conditional tender will be ignored and will not be considered / entertained / accepted.
- 1.8 Original purchase receipt must be enclosed with the tender.
- 1.9 The original printed price list of the manufacturing firm duly stamped & signed should be attaché with the tender and the samples of quoted items must accompany the bids.

- 1.10 Rates should be quoted as per given generic names, however the bidder may also mention the brand name against the generic one.
- 1.11 That specifications given in the tender must be complied with and external and internal warps of the supplied items shall bear the stamp “Government Property / Not for Sale”
- 1.12 The supplier shall provide warranty and batch Nos. at the time of supply of the stores.
- 1.13 The quoted rates shall remain valid till the end of the current financial years.

2. Special Conditions:

- 2.1 Store is required within the stipulated delivery period. No extension will be granted / accorded for the supply of initial quantity.
- 2.2 The bidders shall quote their firm and final price both in figures & words on free delivery basis to consignee end.
- 2.3 Distributor once nominated by the manufacturer will be for the whole contract period and manufacturer can not change its distributor during the year in any case. In exceptional cases the procuring agency may approve changes.
- 2.4 No. manufacturer shall authorize their distributor / agent / any firm or person to quote the same item, which the manufacturer is quoting itself in any tender. Failing those offers of both the manufacturer as well as other bidder shall be ignored.
- 2.5 The supplier shall furnish the certificate from the manufacturer on who's behalf they are participating to the effect that in case of the drug supplied declared sub- standard the participating firm as well as the manufacturer are equally responsible for legal consequences under purchase rules envisaging black listing.
- 2.6 The bidder shall confirm the refund of cost difference if the same medicine / drug is / was supplied as lower rates to any other Govt: semi Govt: institution or Armed forces in the province or out said for local manufacturers in the same fiscal year, if medicines are mfgd: in Sindh and quoted rate to other province is found lower then payment will be made on lower quoted rates to any province.
- 2.7 The purchaser reserves the right to enhance / decrease or delete the quantities at the time of award to contract with out any change in unit price or other terms and conditions of the tender at any item during contract period.
- 2.8 The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals, at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor, who submitted a bid or proposal the ground for its rejection of all bids or proposal, but is not required to justify those grounds. The procuring agency may reject all or any bids subject to the relevant SPPRA Rules.
- 2.9 Subject to the fulfillment of all codal formalities, the purchaser will award the contract to the successful bidders whose bid has been determined to be qualified to perform the contract satisfactory, Both the parties i.e. the purchasers and the supplier will sign the contract agreement on the stamps paper with stamp duties as per prevailing Govt; rules, the expenditure involved on the said contract agreement will be borne by the supplier.

- 2.10 Manufacturing, expiry dates and batch No. will be written on the each pack. No drugs / medicines and disposable item will be accepted having shelf life less than 95% to 100%.
- 2.11 The manufacturer and the supplier both shall be responsible for any breach of the contract agreement and the terms & conditions of the tender.
- 2.12 SPPRA rules shall override all the terms and conditions of the tender.
- 2.13 In case of products declared sub-standard by the PDTL / CDTL or rejected by the inspection committee, the supplier shall have to provide additional quantities of the same.

3. Bid Security.

Every bidder will have to submit bid security in a sealed envelope at the time of tender submission at the rate of 2.5% of the total bid amount. Same will be released after successful completion of stores NOC from consignee and concerned quarters.
